Mitchell Snay (Denison University) received his A.B. in History from the University of Michigan and his Ph.D. from Brandeis University. He is the author of three books: *Gospel of Disunion: Religion and Separatism in the Antebellum South* (Cambridge, UK: Cambridge University Press, 1993), *Fenians, Freedmen, and Southern Whites: Race and Nationality in the Era of Reconstruction* (Baton Rouge: Louisiana University Press, 2007), and *Horace Greeley and the Politics of Reform in Nineteenth-Century America* (Lanham, Maryland: Rowman & Littlefield, 2011).
