Kyle P. Rothemich is a graduate student studying Public History and 19th Century America at West Virginia University. His Honor Thesis entitled, *Evaluating Contested Ground: Civil War Interpretation in the Shenandoah Valley* examines how three sites in the Shenandoah Valley use visitor centers to interpret the American Civil War.
