

ESSENTIAL CIVIL WAR CURRICULUM

Maury Klein was a professor of history at the University of Rhode Island until his retirement in June 2008, teaching a wide variety of courses and writing on a diverse number of subjects. He is author of eighteen books along with many articles in publications ranging from scholarly journals to *Sports Illustrated*, essays, book reviews, and, more recently, blogs. Railroad history emerged early as one of his specialties. Klein's has also authored books on urban history, the coming of the Civil War, the stock market crash of 1929, the steam and electric revolutions, and has a forthcoming work on how America mobilized for World War II. In 2001, he received an honorary degree from Knox College, his alma mater. In 2011, he was inducted into the Rhode Island Heritage Hall of Fame. In 2014 he won an Emmy for best writing on a documentary entitled “Jay Gould: Railroad Man” shown on PBS
