John F. Marszalek (Canisius College, University of Notre Dame) is the author or editor of more than twelve books on Civil War, Jacksonian America, and Race Relations. He served in United States Army Intelligence (1965-1967) including a tour of Vietnam. He has taught at Canisius College (1967-1968), Gannon College (now University)(1968-1973) and Mississippi State University (1973 to 2002) where he was named Giles Distinguished Professor of History and upon retirement Giles Distinguished Professor Emeritus. From 1999 to the present he has served as MSU's Director and Mentor of Distinguished Scholars. In 2008, he was named Executive Director and Managing Editor of the Ulysses S.
