Donald L. Stelluto, Jr. is the Executive Director of the Kellogg Institute for International Studies at the University of Notre Dame. He received his Ph.D. in U.S. constitutional history from the University of Maryland, College Park and he specializes in U.S. constitutional history and the nineteenth century, with a focus on the American Civil War era. Dr. Stelluto is the author of several articles on western legal history, the American South, and the Civil War era, and co-editor, with Vittorio Hosle, of *The Idea of a Catholic Institute for Advanced Study*. His current project, "A light that reveals its true meaning," is a book-length examination of legal and constitutional developments in the Confederacy. He is the project leader and a member of a collaborative team awarded a \$1.58 million research award in 2012 from the John Templeton Foundation.
