

ESSENTIAL CIVIL WAR CURRICULUM

Paul G. Ashdown (University of Tennessee) is a Professor of Journalism with a particular interest in the memory of the Civil War. He is the co-author, with Edward Caudill, of a trilogy focusing on Sherman, Forrest and Mosby as mythic figures shaped by journalism and culture. He is also the author of *A Cold Mountain Companion* and numerous books and articles about the writer James Agee, including “James Agee and the Civil War.”

Edward Caudill (University of Tennessee) is a professor of Journalism and Electronic Media. His scholarship on American cultural and intellectual history includes a trilogy, co-authored with Paul Ashdown, on the development of myths and legends of three prominent Civil War figures: William Tecumseh Sherman, Nathan Bedford Forrest, and John Mosby. He also has written on the impact and interpretation of Darwinism and evolution in American culture.
